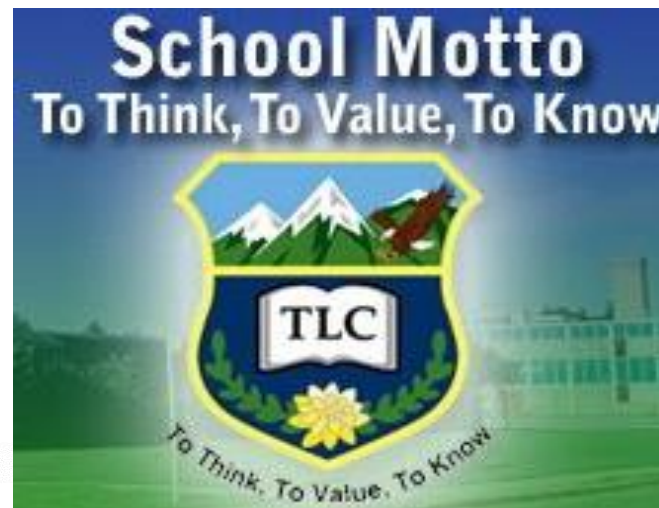
At the Calgary Board of Education, we understand that children bring their own unique talents and gifts to their learning experience. Our dedicated staff know how to help children reach their full potential.

Dates & Timeline



- Families are now able to apply for yellow school bus service for the 2026-27 school year on MY CBE Account. Registrations must be received by June 14, 2026 to ensure students are added to routes for the first day of classes next year. Late registration will continue to be received but will result in a delay in access to the bus route.
- Confirmed bus routes will be posted for families who registered by the deadline in MyCBE in late August.
- The transportation fee is \$500/rider.
- *Lunchroom supervision fee = TBD.*

 - N-Z 12:30 pm – 1:30 pm – parent (s) attend – no bus
- Tuesday, September 1, 2026 – Tuesday/Thursday Group
 - A-M 8:30 am – 9:30 am – parent (s) attend – no bus
 - N-Z 12:30 pm – 1:30 pm – parent (s) attend – no bus
- First day of regularly scheduled classes with bussing:
 - Wednesday, September 2, 2026 – 8:00 am
 - Thursday, September 3, 2026 – 8:00 am
- Watch for further communication on Meet the Teacher and for which families attend which times during staggered entry.

Help Build Confidence before September!



- The transition to kindergarten can be difficult (for parents and kids!) help them out by practicing some things now!
- Name recognition
- Recognition of personal belongings
- Packing a backpack (and putting it on)
- Opening up containers for snack and lunch
- Cleaning up after themselves
- Dressing independently
- Washroom independence (doors are tricky to lock!)

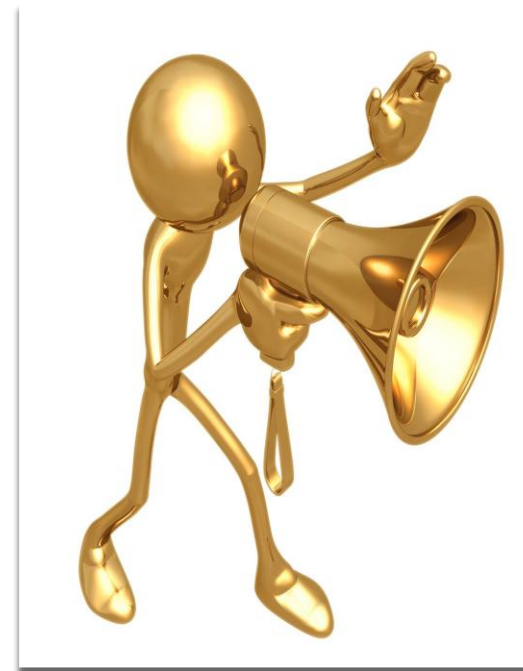
