 - Next Year – the school population will remain similar to the 2025/26 school year.

- Topics of discussion:
 - Class sizes & Complexity: Grades 1-3: 22.73 students; Grades 4-6: 24.98; Grades 7-9: 26.92; Grades 10-12: 29.87. Of the 142+K students there are ~44K EAL and ~27.5K with special needs. Next Year – there will be slight increase in the student population ~ 1 or 2 students per class per grade
 - As of February 12th, 2026 the AB Government announced funding for 118 Classroom Complexity teams (1 teacher and 2 EA's)
 - Budget: CBE is receiving an additional \$60M more than last year for a total of \$1.55B
 - Capital Planning: 3 year school capital plan which includes 26 already approved for planning projects (22 new schools, 2 replacement of schools, 1 modernization of an existing school and 1 addition (Evanston Heights School - August 2026). There are 27 additional projects that have been requested.



- Next COSC meeting is June 10th, 2026 in person
 - Ms. Robinson discussed the our school has recieved a Classroom Complexity team and have been granted the team again for the 2026/27 school year due to our high EAL population. There has been a teacher who has been hired for this position and they are still currently filling both EA positions. The teacher is working in the literacy program.

- Onyinye Ofor asked how the use uniform sale received the uniforms. Ms. Robinson informed the attendees that we receive donations of uniforms from families in the school of which are in good used condition.
