4. Reports
 - a. School Report - Ms. Nadine Robinson
 - January Character education for the month – Perseverance
The students came up with words like Effort, Consistency, Resiliency, not Giving up. A great example from the older grades was Mars Rover.

February Character education for the month – Honesty
Having them to tell what really happened, being truthful, not making up stories and not leaving out important information.

 - The students discussed How to talk through a Landline phone and listen to a landline phone.

b. Principal's Report – Mr. McMahon Michael

- Alberta Education has given the school council \$500 for this school year. Last year, parents signed up and put their names to be drawn, and a book was sent to them. 6 books suggestion was provided, and 5 titles were decided to be picked.
 - The Concert in April will be a little different this year, so we don't have too much workload for the teachers. He mentioned students and teachers are excited about the concert. Costumes will be purchased, so the council will receive some invoices. Sales of tickets will begin after spring break.
 - Cheque writing campaign has been going on and the front office has been collecting cheques and money daily. Rebecca will be available during the Conference to help collect funds as need be and hand it over to Sy.
