



- Appropriate outdoor clothing







Pates & Timeline

- Bussing registration must be completed on MYCBE account **before June 9**(CBE # will be provided in your welcome package)
- Bussing Information: Maps and schedules will be emailed at the end of August
- Bussing fees = TBD and can be paid monthly
- Lunchroom supervision fee = TBD and this can be paid monthly
- Letter from teacher will be sent through email

Is TLC right for my Kindergarten Child?

- Students in Kindergarten have many expectations, both academically and socially. In TLC the basis of our program is around the philosophy of WHOLE GROUP with the Gradual Release of Responsibility Model of instruction. This means for your child to have the best success in this program they need to:
- follow routines without multiple reminders
- sit and listen to instructions and lessons for a minimum of 15 minutes without getting up to move around the room
- work independently on task for a minimum of 10-15 minutes
- demonstrate consistent control and regulation of emotions, behaviours and personal space/boundaries that are age appropriate



Other Information about TLC you need to know

- Parent commitment and involvement is CRUCIAL!
- This means that communication needs to happen on a regular basis between the teacher and parents.
- Review of student work /practice should be completed daily by the children and returned to the school on time
- Uniform expectations need to be followed at ALL times
- Partnership between the school and home goes beyond the classroom and extends to bussing and fieldtrips as well
- Please be sure to sign up for <u>School Messenger before August!</u>
